Targeted interventions for less active, SEND and SEMH pupils has had an impact on building confidence and self-esteem in PE, which has opened up pathways to L2 competitions that some pupils would previously struggle to access. Girls' sports has a raised profile in school. PE recognised with platinum school games award in July 24.
How has your school's spending increased pupil PE and sport activity levels?	Extra-Curricular and lunch clubs: Run 5 days per week and open to all children at school, free of charge. 35 sports offered, ranging from golf and football, to athletics and dance. 300+ children have attended at least one club throughout the year.
How has your school's spending increased school sport participation?	Over 300 pupils have accessed extra curricular clubs throughout the year. We have entered teams for 12 level 2 competitions, we run half-termly intra-school competitions, and we enter SEND teams into specially organised events as appropriate.
How has your school's spending increased pupil participation in extra-curricular activities?	Pupil participation in organised extra-curricular activities has increased through our offer of free daily lunchtime sports coaching for ALL KS2 children, running 4 days per week throughout the year. This, combined with our free-after school offer, has led to increased participation.

We have invested in training and CPD for our new sports subject leader who has taken over responsibility for PE in Summer 24. We have invested in training for identified support staff to develop girls' football. We have supported sports coaching staff in attending local and regional sports training events.

All staff are encouraged to support at least one extra-curricular club during the course of each academic year. This is as part of working hours, and is not funded via the Sports Grant.
