Year 6 Residential Visit

Kingswood Outdoor Centre based in Colomendy, Denbighshire, North Wales. This will be from Wednesday 9th - Friday 11th November 2022.

Expectations:

- Reading is a crucial life skill. Daily reading is essential to success. Children should log their reading activity on 'Go Read'.
- We ask that children read with an adult at home at least three times a week. Your support is greatly appreciated with this.
- ► Times tables these underpin so much of Maths. A secure knowledge and ability to instantly recall all times tables up to 12 x 12 will help your child considerably. Please take time to practise times tables at home, practising them out of order, as well as with the related division facts.
- Example: $7 \times 8 = 56 \quad 56 \div 8 = 7$
- Spellings Please support your child in practising their weekly spellings. These will be handed out on a Monday of each week and there will be a spelling test each Friday.
- We will post useful website links and top tips regularly on Class Dojo. Please ensure that you are set up with this as this is where key messages will be sent and updates posted.
- ▶ Attendance Prompt arrival in school sets children up successfully. Breakfast club is on offer with children able to arrive from 7.35 to enjoy breakfast and a catch up with friends!
- **Booster sessions** As the year progresses, we will be offering after-school booster sessions in Maths and Reading. Invites will be sent out for these; please support your child by ensuring their attendance at these sessions.
